- Enclosed please find the interim report for our Farmer/Grower project # FNE03-469.
 We had a start date later than originally anticipated, but the program is well attended and going well. The original project goals are as follows:
- 2. To establish a comprehensive beef production course for future and current livestock producers throughout New England to gain practical skills and knowledge in raising and marketing beef cattle. This course covers a broad skill set and is tailored towards producers with beginning and intermediate knowledge of raising beef cattle.
- 3. Wolfe's Neck Farm consists of approximately 700 acres and maintains approximately 100 commercial cows. In addition to a commercial working farm, Wolfe's Neck has initiated a significant branded natural beef program that utilizes cooperating farms throughout the Northeast to supply this branded beef program to upscale food service and retail outlets east of the Mississippi.
- 4. Most of the instruction is from Cooperative Extension Educators form Maine. Additional instructors are local veterinarian, fencing supplier, and Maine Department of Agriculture personnel in addition to Wolfe's Neck personnel. I have included a course schedule for your review.
- 5. We are half way through the course. Please refer to schedule.
- There are 12 farms involved in course. Initial polling has seen favorable results building a base for future programs.
