

Members can place orders from Thursday 1 p.m. to Sunday 11 p.m. (a three-day order window, open once every two weeks). A minimum weekly order of \$25 is recommended.

HOW YOUR ORDER IS PACKAGED?

We pick up and repack your ordered food items the day before it is delivered to you. All frozen foods arrive packed with dry ice in insulated boxes. Ice packs keep refrigerated, baked, canned and dry foods cool during shipping. We will reuse insulated boxes to keep costs down.

UPS DELIVERY

Weekly deliveries are made by UPS to individual households on Fridays. You can reuse the shipping box and ice packs if you mail them back to Hometown Foods, 362 Eichybush Rd., Kinderhook,

GROUP SITES

Currently, no group sites are available. When there is a group of members who need delivery to the same shipping address, club members can organize a drop-off site for truck delivery. Typical places might be churches, schools or garages where prepackaged boxes can be delivered and picked up. You will go to your picksup site during its open hours, bringing your own durable insulated cooler to transfer your order. Boxes will be broken down, stored at the site and returned at the next delivery for reuse.
