

This shed homes the receiving tanks for the milk, piped in from the right.



Holding tank for the sheep's milk.



The tank is on wheels so that it can be hitched to a tractor and hauled to the cheese-making shed.



Holding area for the sheep, while they are waiting to be milked.



The sheep walk up the ramp on the right, into the milkhouse. The milkhouse is built with a high roof, to be cool in the summer and covered in clear plastic, to admit plenty of light. The milk is pumped through the overhead pipe to a receiving tank off to the left.
