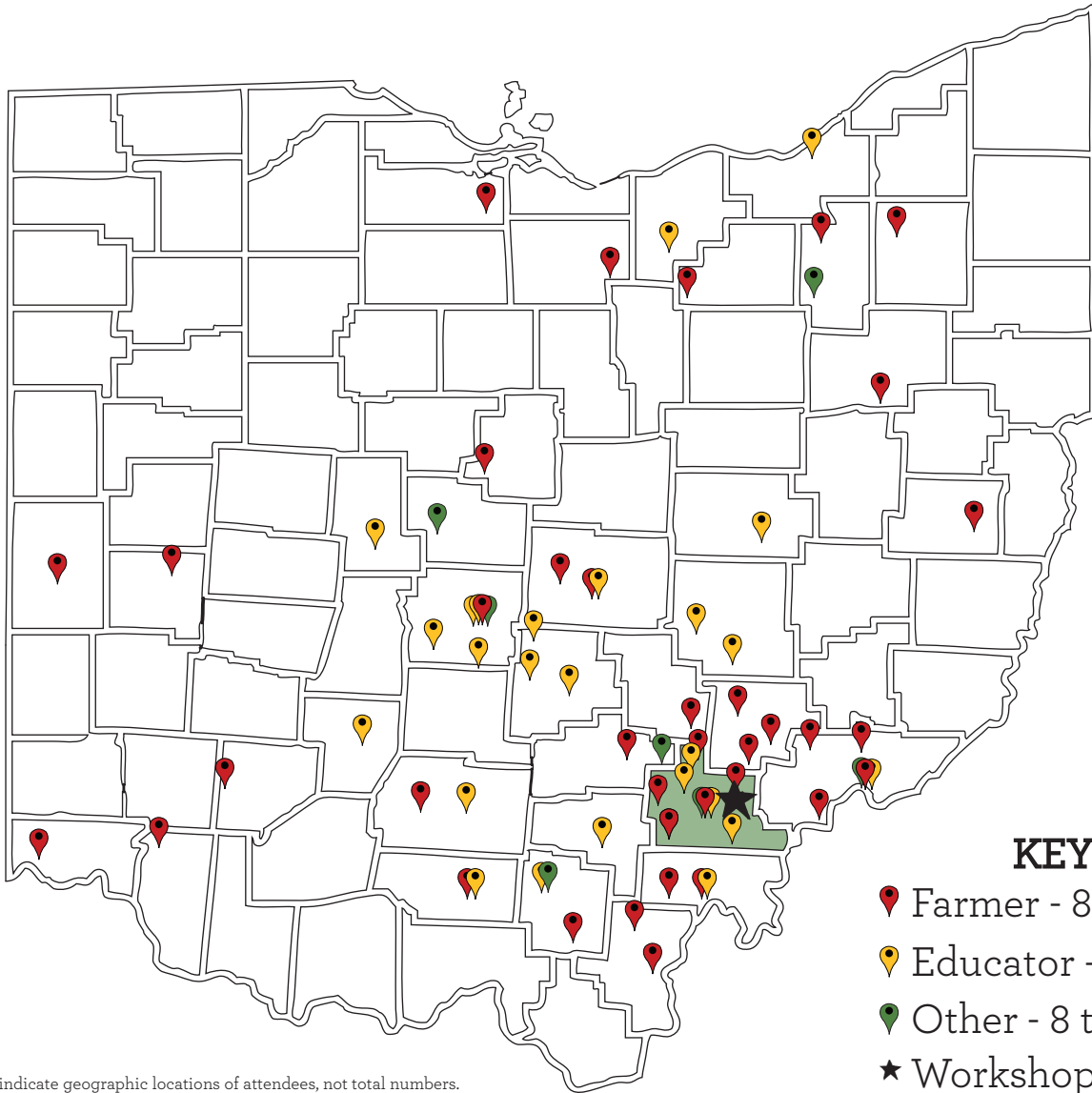






# Season Creation

Since December 2012, Rural Action and Green Edge Organic Gardens have brought together and trained over 175 farmers and educators at Green Edge’s Amesville, Ohio farm where they’ve introduced the Season Creation model of winter growing. Attendees have included 17 USDA NRCS Conservationists and 7 OSU Extension Educators. This model trains farmers, consumers, and educators on the use of gabled high tunnels to grow and sell climate suited specialty crops year-round.

The map above shows the locations of all Season Creation workshop attendees. Through funding from USDA Sustainable Agriculture Research and Education, the Appalachian Partnership for Economic Growth, and the Athens Foundation; Rural Action and Green Edge have developed and spread the Season Creation model statewide to a wide variety of sustainable agriculture stakeholders, in the SARE case specifically targeting NRCS and OSU Extension personnel on a multi-county level.
