Hearthstone Berry Farm, a small pick-your-own farm in Nova, received a grant to study the possibility of raising figs in unheated high tunnels. They were awarded a grant to study figs as a niche crop. USDA SARE gives educational and outreach grants to farmers and ranchers to study a host of topics including sustainability, crops, production efficiency, pollinators and more. Each grant has an outreach and education component.

The field day at Hearthstone Berry Farm will run from 11:00 to 12:30 on Saturday September 21 and is the first field day for this two-year fig project. The program and tour will look at the fig research and discuss the problems and potentials going forward. We will also look at a prior SARE-funded elderberry trial and discuss how that has been used to educate growers. Finally we can look at several blackberry varieties that the farm is growing to increase the harvest season and answer
