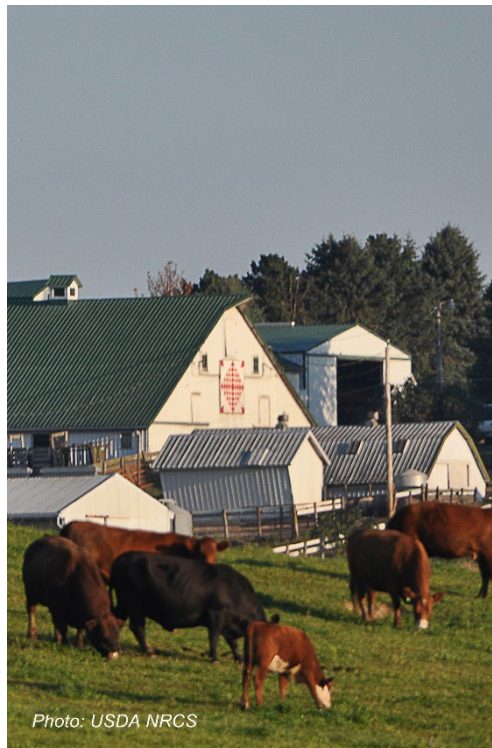




# GROWING ORGANIC EXPERTISE IN IOWA
