#### Summary

This was a somewhat younger group of individuals who ranged in age from under 25 to 54. The larger majority was between 25 and 54 (69%). A slight majority were men, but the group divided almost evenly between men and women. Four had less than a high school degree, and only 3 had a four-year degree or higher. Two participants were still high school students; the rest were adult learners. Two participants were veterans or National Guard Members. Five were Farm Fellows but all had a background in agriculture.

All students were either much or very much satisfied with the training overall, the engagement of the instructors, and the educational materials. They all said that they would use the information that learned from the workshop in their agriculture operation.
