

Birds play critical ecological roles including helping control insects, dispersing seeds, and serving as prey for a diversity of wildlife species. The presence or absence of bird species can also be an indicator of environmental health. Knowing how to identify bird species and understanding which bird species could be present can help landowners and land managers better realize their lands' contribution to bird conservation and range health.
