STALKS TO PROFIT

Stalks to Juice: **100 lbs** of sorghum stalks can yield **45-50 lbs of raw juice**.

Juice to syrup: **6-12 gallons of raw juice** yield **one gallon** of sweet sorghum syrup.

Syrup per acre: Sorghum cane could yield **150 gallons of syrup per acre**.

Syrup to Profit: Current market prices are **\$40/gallon**.
