

# Tree Assessment

This form is to be used for in-person assessment of pre-selected trees. The Tree ID# is the number that links back to the information used to nominate the tree for assessment. Make sure the Tree ID# is available and correct before conducting the assessment of a tree.

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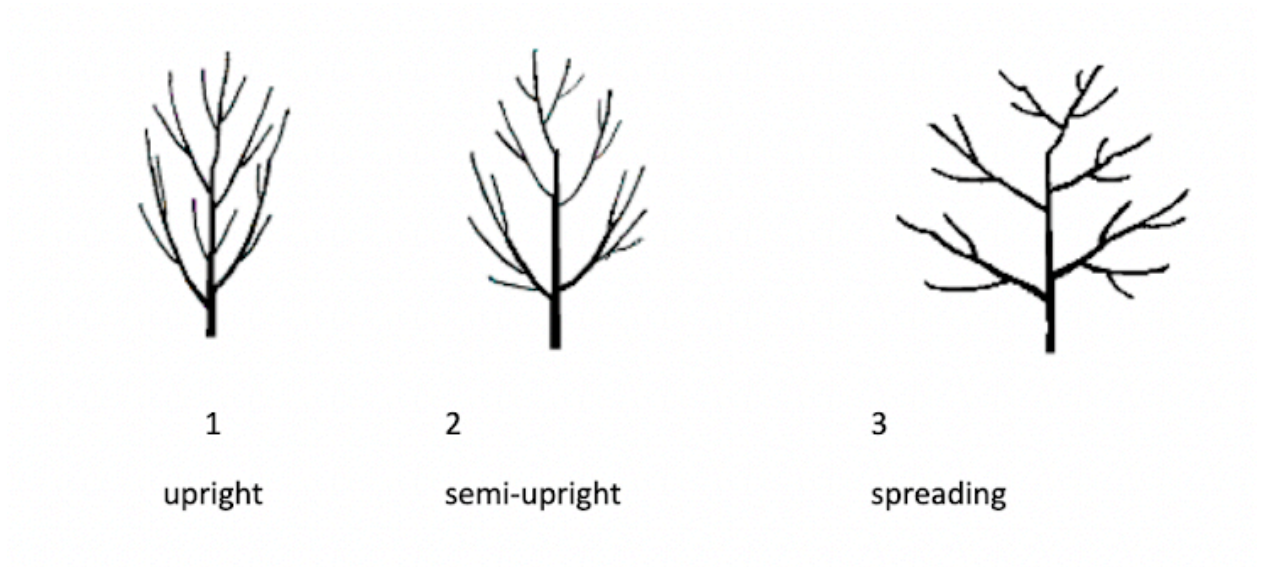

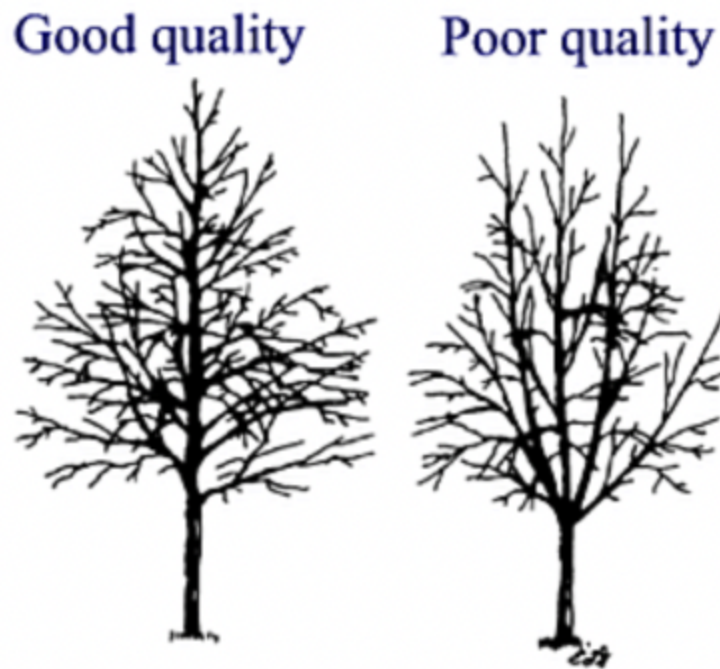

- ☐ The stem is in good condition (solid, with no visible damage).
- ☐ The stem shows some damage (mechanical injury, insect holes, woodpecker wounds) but is mostly in good condition.
- ☐ The stem shows lots of damage and is in poor condition

13. All branches are less than about two-thirds the trunk diameter



*Mark only one oval.*

- ☐ True - no concern (good quality)
- ☐ False - higher potential for branch splitting (poor quality)

14. Leaf condition (unrelated to seasonal leaf color change)

*Mark only one oval.*

- ☐ A few yellow leaves
- ☐ A few branches have yellow/brown leaves while the others still have green leaves
- ☐ More than a third of leaves that look unhealthy (ex. brown spots, scorching, dull, thinning) and/or there are signs of branch dieback (lack of leaves near branch tips)



15. Tree health red flags: check if present. There is an opportunity later to upload up to 3 photos of specific concerns.

☐ Excessive staining of the bark surface



☐ Presence of beetle holes in bark or galleries in branches or the trunk



☐ Presence of cankers or bleeding wounds
