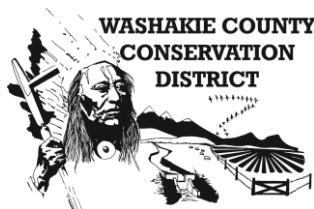

WY, with permanent fenced pastures ranging from 70 to 1000 acres, Justin and Riki Kremers have increased available forage by recapturing previously ungrazeable acres and better utilizing the remaining.
