# **COMMENTS:**

The pH, sulfate, alkalinity and total dissolved solids exceed the EPA suggested limits for domestic use.

Sodium exceeds the EPA drinking water health advisory limit for domestic use. The EPA has not set a maximum contaminant level (MCL) for sodium in municipal water supplies where it is required to have sodium below a legal limit. They have determined that there may be a health issue for individuals on sodium restricted diets if the sodium level exceeds 20 ppm.
