- 1. Applicant has the educational background and/or experience to facilitate the level of training we intend to provide and extend that training to support the educational and technical assistance soil health needs of their clients.
- 2. Applicant has experience in organizing and facilitating educational events such as workshops, field days, tours, demonstrations and presentations; especially relating to soil health.
- 3. The applicant's employment situation provides ample opportunity to interact with farmers in group and/or one on one situations.
- 4. Applicant demonstrates they have an existing client base ready and willing to expand their soil health activities.
- 5. Applicant has their employer's support to attend the training and to conduct soil health related educational and/or technical assistance activities.
- 6. Applicant's identified training needs align with the training we intend to provide.
- 7. Consideration of the applicant's explanation of how this training will help them in advancing the clients soil health activities.
- 8. Consideration of our costs to support the applicant's training (travel and lodging).
