The Hop Yard was visited on July 10th before the sheep were put into the yard to graze. There was both broadleaf and grass weeds present. The grass weed pressure was very high in the rows. The individual species were not identified because of the similarities in potential control strategies for all grass species. The broadleaf weed pressure was also very high in the rows and the list of species present is included below.
