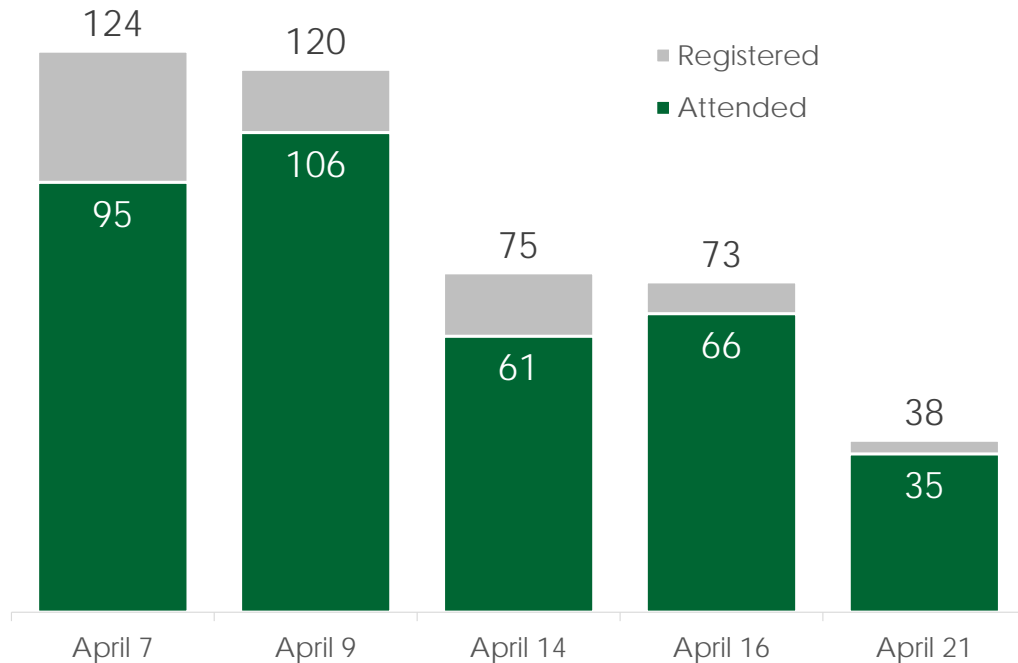

## Participation

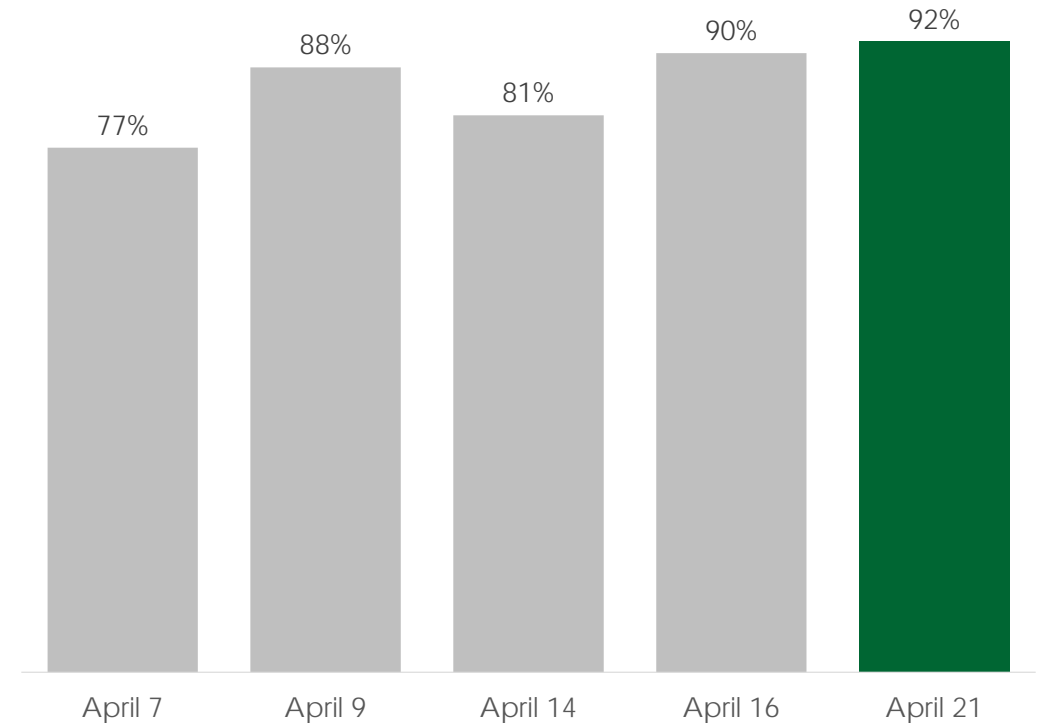
\*Note that speakers and organizers were eliminated from these numbers. As were participants who did not attend at least one full talk/session.

A total of 203 unique participants attended the webinar series. Attendance numbers show attrition from the first to the last session, while attendance rates (attended/registered) steadily increased. **April 9<sup>th</sup> was the most attended webinar of the series (106 participants).**

Zip codes for 173 of the participants show great geographic reach.

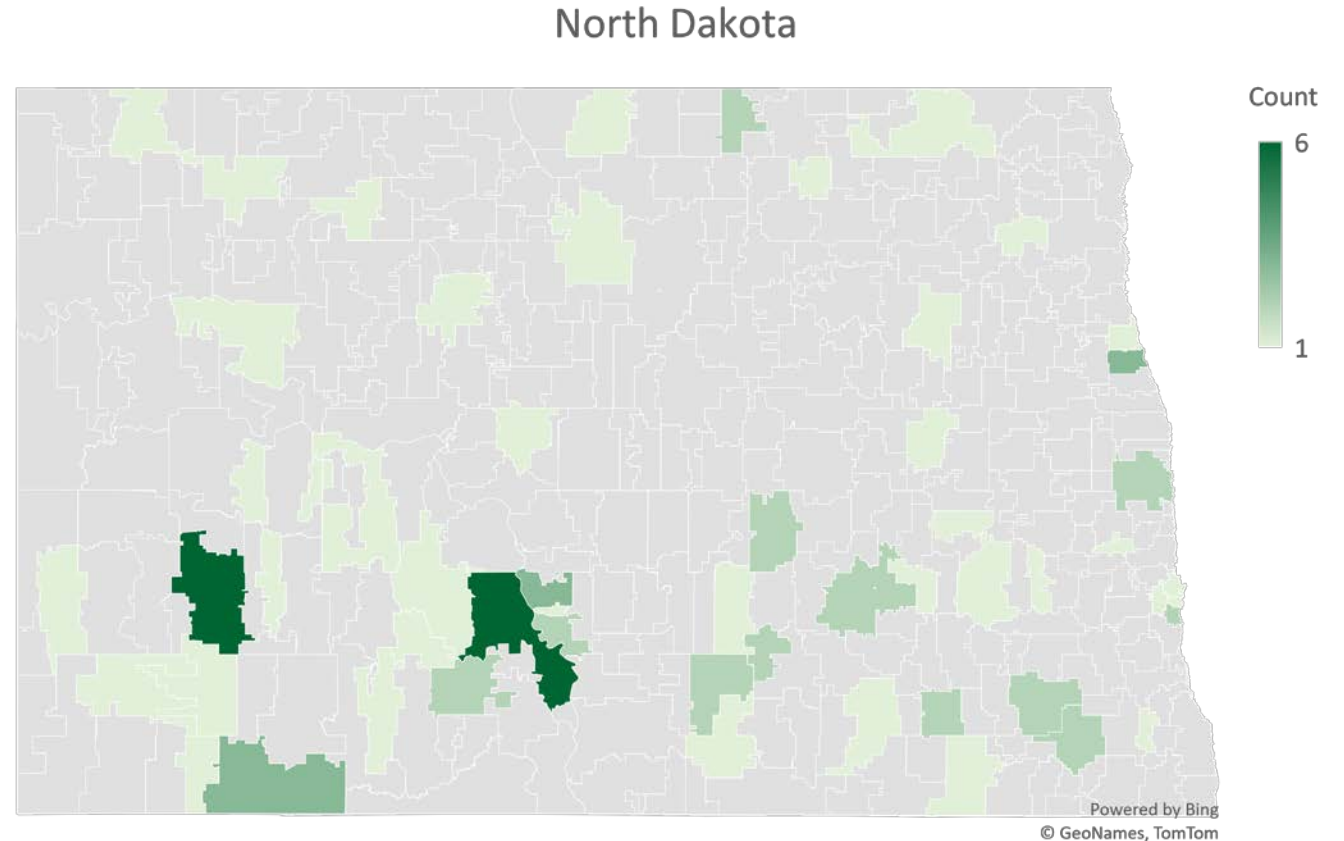

## North Dakota Participants

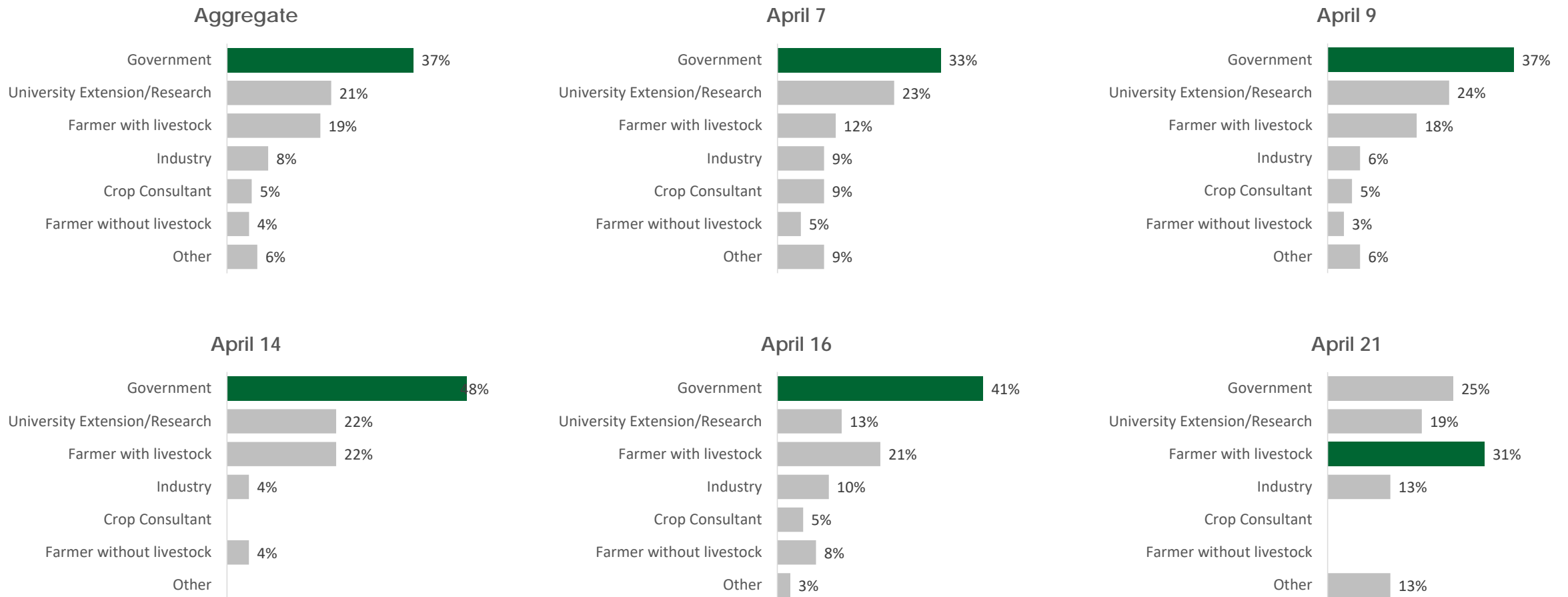
49% of webinar participants who provided zip codes are from in North Dakota.

It will be interesting to look at the distribution of webinar vs workshop registrants.



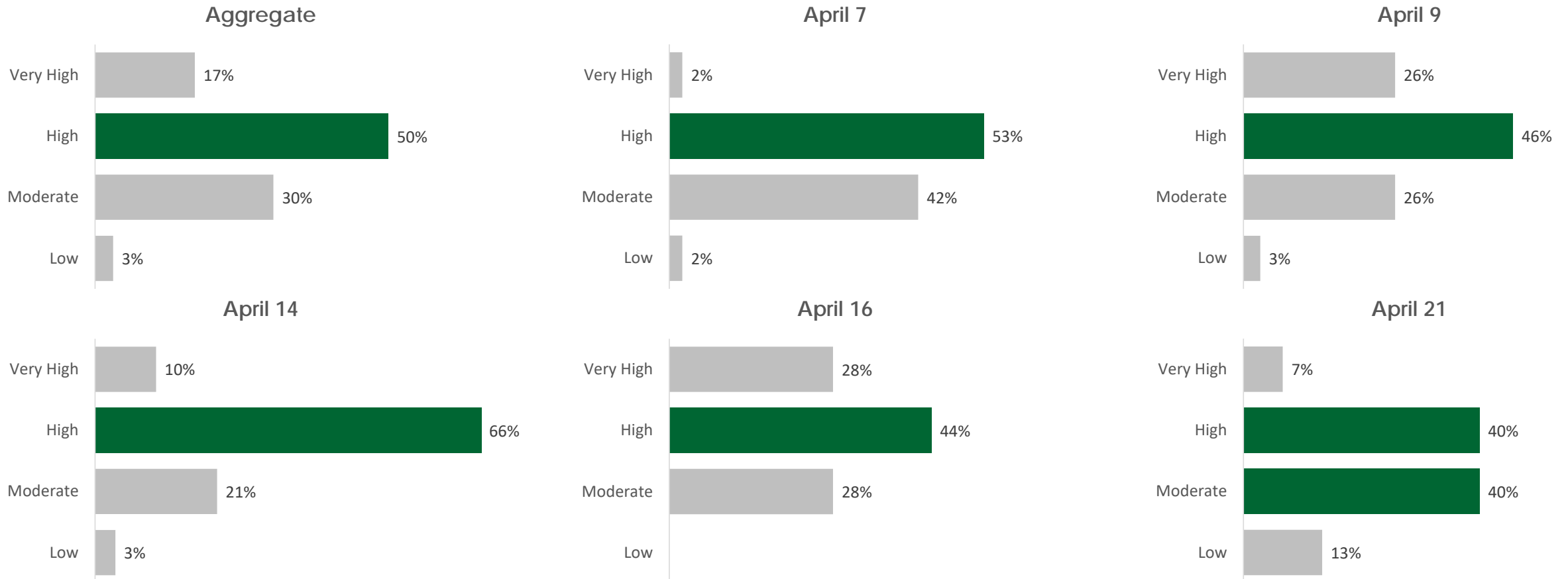
## Affiliation

Government employees represent the largest overall group for all but the **last webinar**, where **farmers with livestock were the largest group** represented (**31%**).



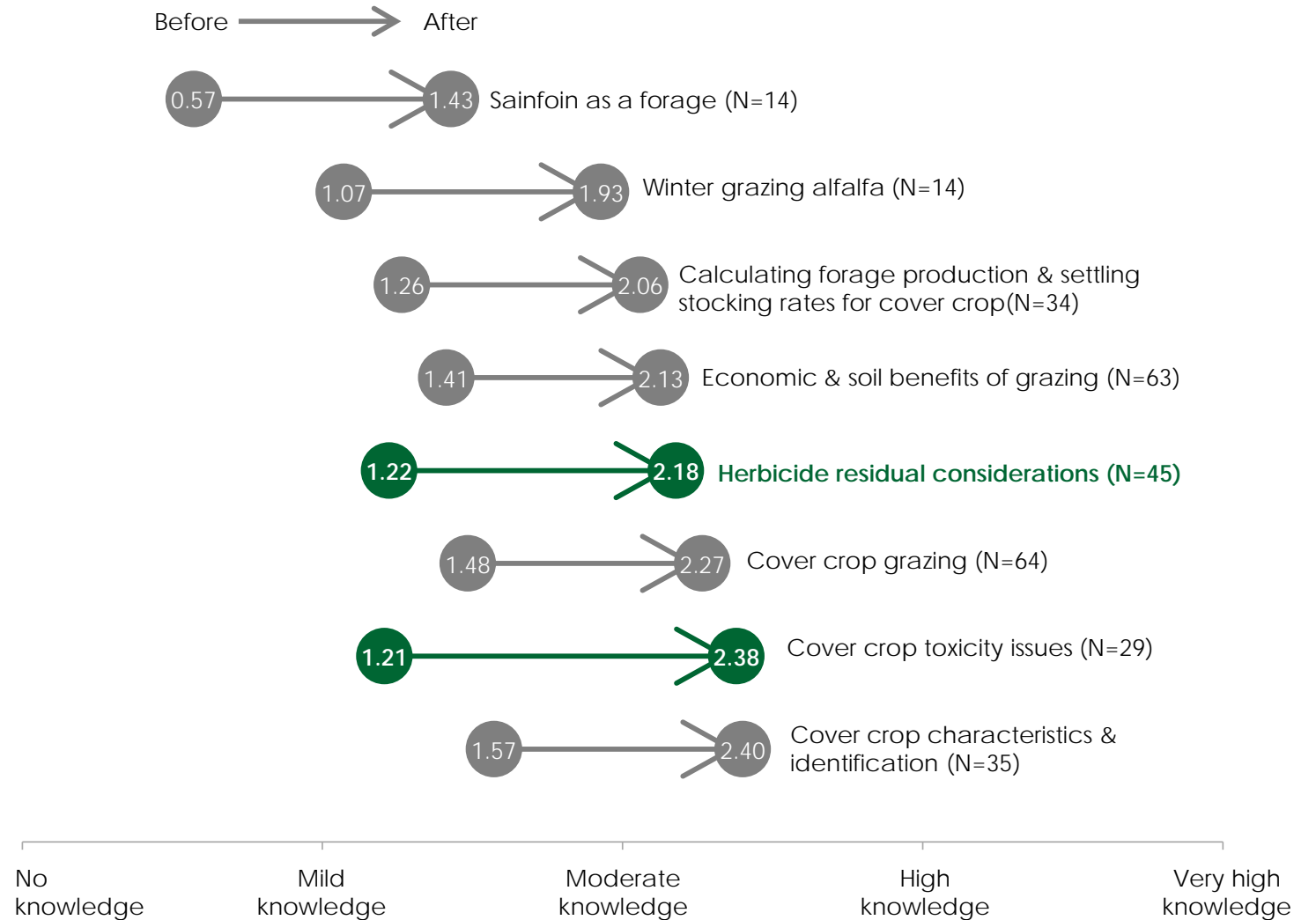
## Webinar Usefulness

Overall respondents found the webinars useful for their work. **April 14<sup>th</sup> appears to have been the most successful** with 76% rating it high to very high usefulness. **April 21<sup>st</sup> appears to have been least successful** with 53% rating it low to moderately useful.



## Knowledge Change

On a scale from no knowledge (zero) to very high knowledge (four), the average knowledge of respondents increased in all areas. The **greatest change in average knowledge** was on **cover crop toxicity issues** (increased 1.17 points) and **herbicide residual considerations** (increased 0.96 point).
