6 plants per plot, in bio-degradable black plastic-mulched (already breaking down), drip irrigated beds (3.5 ft wide, 5.0 ft on-center), 30 inches within row spacing = plots 15 ft long X 4 reps. Transplanted plants $^{\sim}6/23/23$ by hand into pre-formed beds with pre-punched holes.
