Have you ever considered raising a crop of brassicas for sheep or cattle feed? Here's a chance to see the process and a little bit of the results first hand. Edgefield Farm is conducting a study, partially funded by a Sustainable Agriculture Research and Education (SARE) grant, of three different lamb finishing programs: one using pasture and supplemental grain, one using turnips, and one using kale.

Come to a pasture walk and see the crops and the lambs grazing them. Shepherd Bill Foshier will discuss the benefits of the project to date, as well as some of the challenges he has faced. We'll discuss plant productivity, animal gains, economic considerations, and anything else of interest to the group. Light refreshments will be provided.
