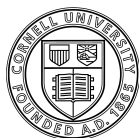
Forage brassica crops are closely related to vegetables like turnips and broccoli, but they are bred for high yields of high quality forage for grazing animals. These crops are palatable and have high levels of digestible energy for ruminant nutrition.
