- 1) Agree to participate every week from time of signing up and receive the best prices on local produce.
- 2) Choose the payment option that is right for you.
- 3) Sign-ups starting in March 2012

**PRICING:** *(these prices might change for 2012 season)*

**3 Options if you qualify for 3Squares VT food stamps,** (you don't have to receive them). Prices comparable to Price Chopper conventional produce. We ask for at least a 2-week down payment upon signing up.

*9 Veggie Basket for \$20.00/Week*

*5 Veggie Basket for \$11.00/Week*

*3 Veggie Basket for \$7.00/Week*

*Example: 1 Veggie= 1 Bunch of Carrots. You choose your veggies.*

**3 Options if you do not qualify for food stamps.** We ask that, if possible, you pay for the whole season upfront, but will work with you to find a payment schedule that works for you.

*9 Veggie Basket for \$25/week or \$375/Season*

*5 Veggie Basket for \$14/week or \$210/Season*

*3 Veggie Basket for \$8.50/week or \$125/Season*

If neither of these options works for you, let us know and we can help you find what you are looking for.
