VOLUNTEERING

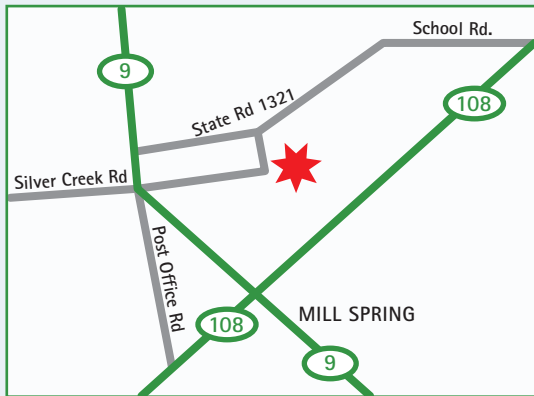
We welcome all kinds of labor. Professional and non-professional painting, carpentry, yard work, landscaping and general labor. The more the merrier!
