Chicago Botanic Garden Farmers' Market 1st & 3rd Sunday of Month (June 5 – October 16, 2011), 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

For the fourth season of the Farmers' Market, the Garden welcomes local, sustainable farmers to this public market on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month, June through October. Vendors offer seasonal products such as fruits, vegetables, cut flowers and herbs. Also hand-made pottery and honey.

Highlights:

- We are moving to the Esplanade this year! Vendors will line the Esplanade under the Elm trees providing great visibility and shopping ease.
 - O July 3 the market will be in the space just north of the Visitor Center due to the Chicago Botanic Garden Art Festival taking place on the Esplanade.
- There will be various 'vendor talks' with the public regarding sustainable practices and other topics. These talks will take place at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. in the Farmers' Market area and are funded by a SARE grant.
