The Great River Road Wine Trail holds its Grand Opening with a Mid-Summer Festival on Saturday and Sunday, June 20th and 21st, 11:00 am – 6:00 pm. This new wine trail links wineries in Wisconsin, Minnesota, and Iowa. The nine wineries on the trail will each present their special offerings with free samples available to the general public. Some wine trail members will also have special food items available for purchase at the event. In addition to enjoying the wines and activities at each winery, guests can also enjoy the celebrations occurring in the various villages and towns along the trail. Garvin Heights Vineyards, Winona, MN will have a Midsummer bonfire at sundown on Saturday, weather permitting.
