Introduction

The demand for local food among schools in Maine is rising. Schools in Maine spend over \$42 million on food; your work with local producers makes it possible for some of that money to stay in the state.

For the past five years, Healthy Acadia has been spearheading the farm to school effort. The Downeast Farm to School coordinators work with 1) school cooks to support local food purchasing, 2) educators who teach about food systems and nutrition, and 3) producers to sell to nearby institutions. Things to Consider

when starting a farm to school relationship







SIZE: Successful sales relationships require farms and schools with complementary needs. Small schools and small farms should seek each other out; the same is true for larger schools.

COMMUNICATION: Be sure to find a way to stay in touch with the producer you work with; they can provide weekly e-mails, faxes or phone calls. Ask them to let you know what is in season, how the products look, and what's on sale this week.

TIMING: Let the producer know when you would like to place and receive food orders. Connecting ahead of time will help - you will have more time to plan your menu.

DELIVERY: Talk to the producer about when and how often he/ she will make deliveries. Find out where they drop off the food products and ask for an invoice. There may be a minimum order for each delivery or a delivery fee.

PRODUCT QUALITY: Ask that the products are packaged appropriately and washed for kitchen use.

Keep in mind:

- Be straightforward about your minimum requirements and desired producer profile
- 2. Be ready to ask questions to understand their situation
- 3. Work with your producer to agree upon good communication methods right away

PRODUCT DIVERSITY and USE: Buying local foods gives you access to varieties of food that often cannot be purchased in stores. Try new products and ask your producer for recipes.

PRICE: Ask for a price list from the producer. Recognize that their products may be more expensive than food you can buy because there are no middle-men and most of the labor is done by hand. If you are unsure that produce is priced fairly, compare it to the price reports at www.mofga.org

SEASONALITY: The assumption is that produce is only available in summer months in Maine, and schools start after the height of summer bounty. Ask the producer if they use tools to extend seasons or if they store crops over the winter. Also, try to find local foods that are available year round such as milk, meat, and flour.


