From Greensburg and Route 30

Dr. Ray Nebel - Dr. Nebel is Vice President of Technical Services Programs and Senior Reproductive Specialist for Select Sires Inc. Dr. Nebel also serves as Adjunct Professor of Animal Science at The Ohio State University.



Dr. Alex Hristov - Dr. Hristov is an Associate Professor in the Department of Dairy and Animal Science at Penn State University. Dr. Hristov's research has focused on reducing protein feeding in lactating dairy cattle to improve air quality by reducing ammonia emissions and improve dairy profitability. Before coming to Penn State, Dr. Hristov was Associate Professor in the Department of Animal and Veterinary Science at the University of Idaho.
