Thanks for agreeing to help out with the SARE Farmer Ranger Grant "DEMONSTRATING A QUCK-START PROCESS TO HELP SMALL FARMERS BEGIN TRANSITION TO ORGANIC PRACTICES.

After a late weather-related start, we are up and running with this project. Two farms - Dave Harn's in Grand Junction with 2.0 A of Bluecrop) and Raphael & Minerva Salgado's (2.5 A of Jerseys) in Covert - have joined with us and our Bangor Farm (1.8 A of Jerseys) in this two year project. All three plots are surrounded by wooded areas.

We've set up a schedule (attached) that is open to modification. At present, we have trimmed the fields, hand-weeded them and sprayed Sulferex. We are collecting 2013 spray records and have asked for soil samples. We are also documenting last year's yield. We encourage your advice and counsel as we move forward.

We will provide more detail shortly. The grant provides travel funds for at least two visits to the area and a field day at the end. Mark Longstroth is helping us organize a field visit hopefully in mid-June.
