



Button bush (left) and silky dogwood (right) grown two mixes composed of either bark-peat-sand (peat) or bark-ADDF-sand (ADDF-peat) in a ratio of 4:2:1. The peat mix was amended with  $2.5\text{g L}^{-1}$  and the ADDF mix was amended with  $4\text{g L}^{-1}$  gypsum. There were no differences in size, stem caliper or number of stems between woody plants grown in the peat mix and ADDF-peat mix after one growing season.
