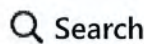

This year, several of our members will be showing various breeds of quail. They raise the birds for meat and egg production, dog and raptor training.

We plan to install a greenhouse and an axe yard. We have a 14-acre park to enjoy. Sap is also being collected for making maple syrup in our back 40. Future plans also include placing bee hives to be able to collect and sell the honey for a fundraiser.

This summer or late spring, we will be having safety classes on knife/fire safety. Each member that graduates from class will receive a special card to allow them to carry an edge implement (axe, knife, tomahawk, hoe, etc.) and build a fire.

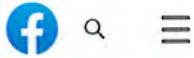

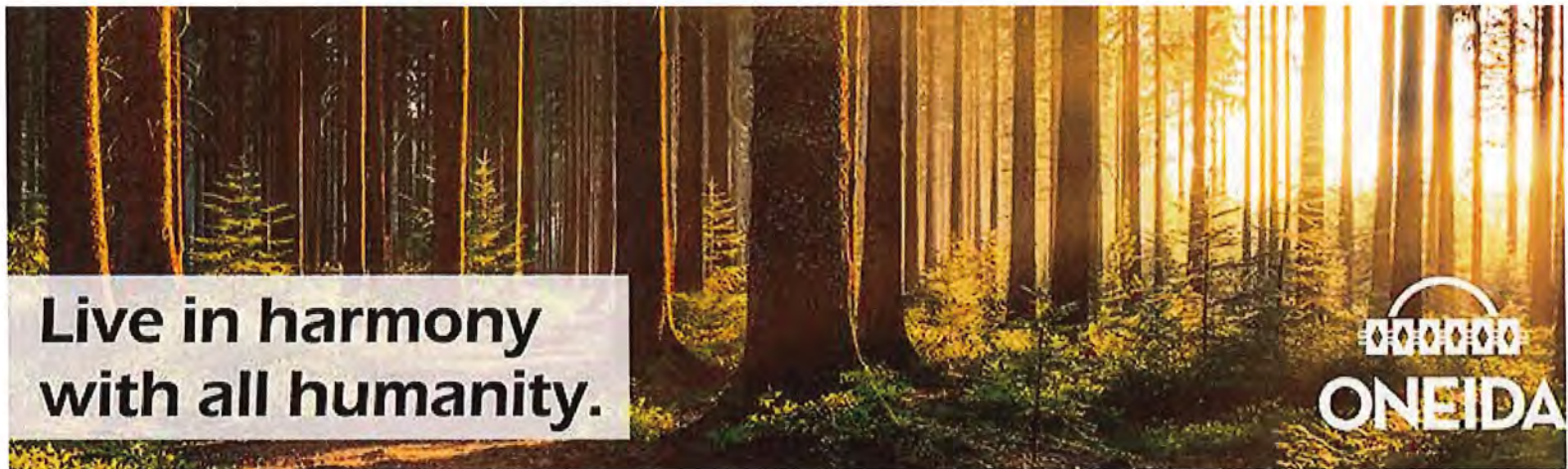
