

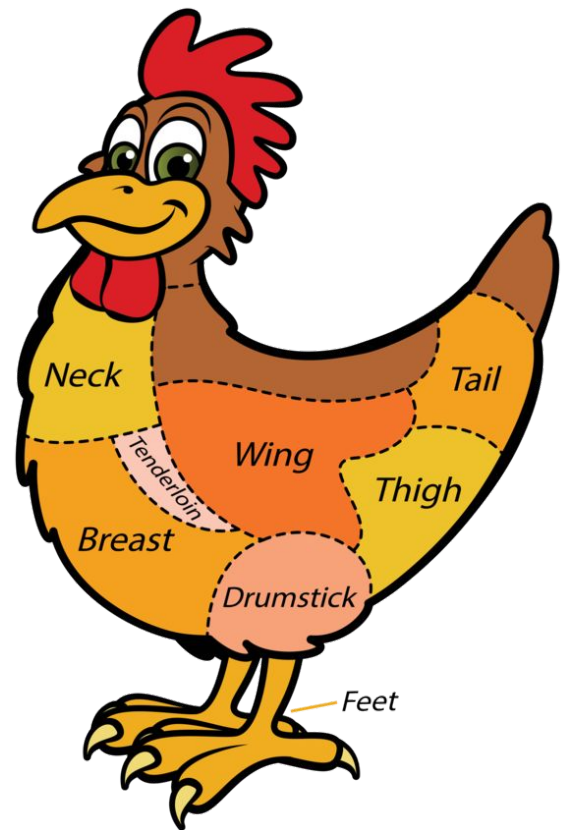


Each chicken usually lays
