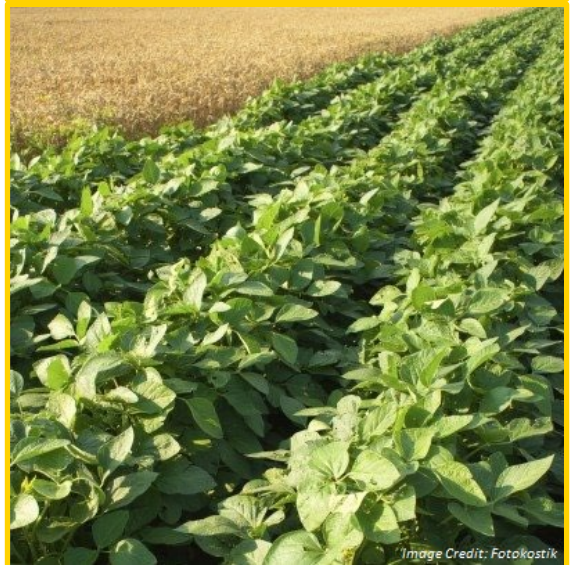


Enrich Soil Health
