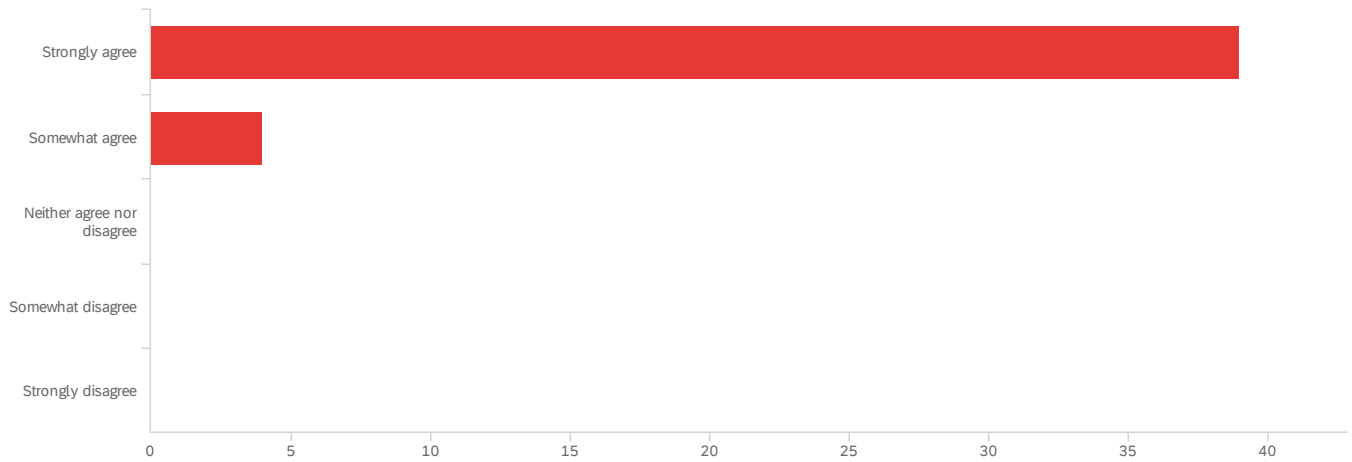

One interesting thing we notice on our farm is that transition from full-width surface tillage and cultivation to high-residue no-till has greatly reduced disease pressure on crops like brassica oleracea. I think that one big part of this is that soil doesn't splash on the leaves. It allows us to grow these crops with low disease pressure even with overhead irrigation.
