Buy your groceries from the co-op by:

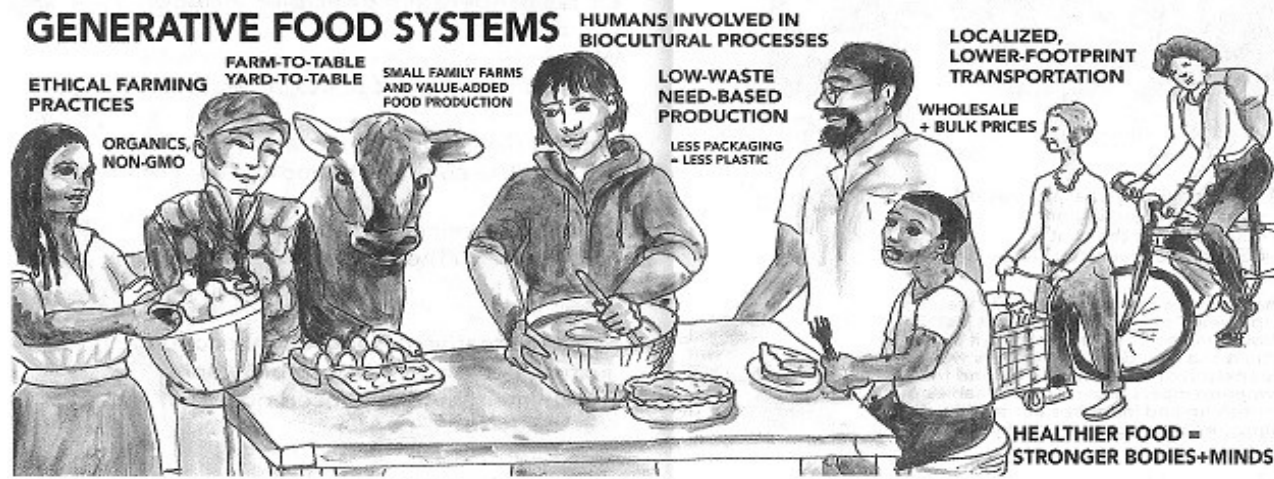
- **Shopping at the sliding- scale store**, 6917 S. Broadway.

The deadline for non-stock items is Mondays at midnight for pickup the following Saturday. On Hand orders may be placed at any time, usually with 24-hour turnaround. All items in the catalog are either sourced locally or come from a natural foods supplier. This means that all produce is organic (unless otherwise noted) and all products represent one or more alternatives to commercial food supplies: natural ingredients, health-oriented, sustainable growing practices, small / cooperative business model, fair labor practices, low energy use, fair trade, socially responsible, etc.
