Who can participate? We realizes the need to tie-in to, and help support, our communities. Therefore, up to 60% of the farmers, ranchers and participants in our group have no military affiliation. As well, we work with rural schools to help them supplement their cafeterias with more nutritious-rich, fresh foods, and assist in local community gardening projects.
