<i>Physocarpus opulifolius</i> 'Seward' Summer Wine™	5-6'	Purple-bronze foliage
<i>Physocarpus opulifolius</i> 'Donna May' Little Devil™	3-4'	Purple-green foliage
<i>Physocarpus opulifolius</i> 'SMPOTW' Tiny Wine™	3-4'	Dark bronze-maroon foliage
<i>Physocarpus opulifolius</i> 'Bert Darts G' Festivus Gold™	3-4'	Yellow foliage
<i>Rhus typhina</i> 'Bailtigr' Tiger Eyes®	3-6'	Yellow foliage

## Replacements to match red fall color of Winged Euonymus

<i>Aronia arbutifolia</i>	5-7'	Red fall color; red glossy berries
<i>Aronia melanocarpa</i>	4-6'	Orange-red-purple fall color; black fruits
<i>Aronia melanocarpa</i> (UCONN compact selection)	2'	Red-purple fall color; dense branching
<i>Cornus racemosa</i> 'Hurzam' Huron®	2-3'	Burgundy-red fall color; dense globe
<i>Cornus racemosa</i> 'Muszam' Muskingum®	2-3'	Brick red fall color; scented flowers
<i>Cornus racemosa</i> 'Slavinii'	2-3'	Red-purple fall color; dense habit
<i>Cornus stolonifera</i> 'Fallow' Arctic Fire™	3-5'	Red-purple fall color; red winter stems
<i>Cornus stolonifera</i> 'Kelseyi'	3-5'	Brick red fall color; red winter stems
<i>Cornus stolonifera</i> 'Bailhalo' Ivory Halo®	3-4'	Variegated foliage; dark red winter stems
<i>Cornus stolonifera</i> 'NeilZ' Pucker Up™	3-5'	Puckered glossy foliage
<i>Eubotrys racemosa</i>	4-6'	Red fall color; high deer resistance
<i>Prunus pumila</i> var. <i>depressa</i>	1'	Orange-red fall color; white flowers
<i>P. pumila</i> var. <i>susquehanae</i> × <i>P. pumila</i> var. <i>depressa</i> (UCONN selection)	1-2'	More upright with larger leaves than var. <i>depressa</i> ; orange-red fall color
<i>Rhus aromatica</i>	4-6'	Orange-red fall color
<i>Rhus aromatica</i> 'Gro-low'	1'	Orange-red fall color
<i>Vaccinium angustifolium</i>	1-2'	Difficult to establish; acidic soils

<i>Vaccinium corymbosum</i>	5-7'	Acidic soils
<i>Vaccinium staminium</i>	3-5'	Potential broad adaptability
<i>Viburnum nudum</i> var. <i>nudum</i> 'Bulk' Brandywine™	5-6'	Heavy fruit set; maroon-red fall color
<i>Viburnum nudum</i> var. <i>nudum</i> 'Winterthur'	5-6'	Shiny, deep green foliage; red fall color

### **Other compact plant to replace Japanese barberry or Winged Euonymus**

<i>Cephalanthus occidentalis</i> 'SMCOSS' Sugar Shack™	3-4'	Showy, round white flowers
<i>Comptonia peregrina</i>	2-3'	Scented, fern-like foliage
<i>Corylus americana</i>	5-6'	Multi-hued fall color, edible nut
<i>Corylus americana</i> 'Little Filly' (UCONN selection)	3-4'	More compact habit and smaller leaves
<i>Corylus cornuta</i>	5-6'	Attractive foliage, edible nut
<i>Diervilla lonicera</i>	2-3'	Yellow flowers, long bloom period
<i>Diervilla lonicera</i> 'Copper'	2-3'	Copper-red new growth
<i>Ilex verticillata</i> 'FarrowBP' Berry Poppins™	3-4'	Heavy fruiting; compact habit
<i>Ilex verticillata</i> 'FarrowMP' Mr. Poppins™	3-4'	Male pollinator for 'FarrowBP', 'NCIV1'
<i>Ilex verticillata</i> 'Jim Dandy'	3-6'	Male pollinator for 'Red Sprite'
<i>Ilex verticillata</i> 'NCIV1' Little Goblin™	3-5'	Heavy fruiting; compact habit
<i>Ilex verticillata</i> 'Red Sprite'	3-5'	Heavy fruiting; compact habit
<i>Juniperus communis</i>	3-4'	Evergreen foliage
<i>Juniperus communis</i> 'AmiDak' Blueberry Delight®	6"-1'	Silvery blue needles and berries
<i>Juniperus communis</i> 'Effusa'	1'	Dark green evergreen foliage
<i>Juniperus horizontalis</i> cultivars	6"-1'	Evergreen foliage
<i>Juniperus virginiana</i> 'Grey Owl'	2-3'	Silver grey, scaly evergreen foliage
<i>Juniperus virginiana</i> 'Kosteri'	3-5'	Broad-spreading; purple fall color
<i>Morella pensylvanica</i> (UCONN compact selection)	2'	Densely branching with large fruits
<i>Morella pensylvanica</i> 'Bobzam' Bobbee™	6'	Aromatic foliage, waxy silver-blue fruits
<i>Morella pensylvanica</i> 'Morton' Silver Sprite™	6'	Aromatic foliage, waxy silver-blue fruits
<i>Myrica gale</i>	1-2'	Scented, frosty lime-green foliage
<i>Potentilla fruticosa</i> cultivars	2'	Cultivars with different flower colors
